2009-2010 VOLUNTEER POLICY GUIDELINE

2009-2010 Volunteer Requirements

- Multiple Player families are asked to distribute their volunteerism between all teams
- The season begins May 1, 2009 through April 30, 2010
- It is your responsibility to seek volunteer opportunities

Level of oldest player	Minimum number of volunteer hours
Oldest Player is Mini-Mite	0
Single player Mite	8
Multiple Player family all players must be Mite	10
Single Player Squirt/U10 & above	12
Multiple Player family, oldest player is Squirt/U10 & above	16

The following positions will fulfill ALL required volunteer hours.

Buy out or insufficient hours:

You have the option to buy out your volunteer hours if you so choose. You **must** submit your buy out payment with your registration form/payment. The association will also bill for any incomplete volunteer hours. The fees are determined by oldest player, they are as follows:

Player Level	Registration Buyout	Unfulfilled Hours Maximum Billed
Single Mites	\$ 400.00	\$ 800.00
Multiple Player Mites	\$ 500.00	\$ 1,000.00
Single Squirt and above/Girls U10 and above	\$ 600.00	\$ 1,200.00
Multiple Player Squirt and above/Girls U10 above	\$ 800.00	\$ 1,600.00

If you complete a portion of the required hours you will be billed \$100.00 for each unfulfilled hour up to the maximum. Failure to show for a volunteer position will result in a penalty of \$100.00 for each incident reported. This is in **addition to the maximum**. Please keep in mind that the goal of the Volunteer Policy is to distribute the huge workload among all of the WYHA families.

Who can be a Volunteer - Any family member age 21 and older may volunteer for any opportunity. Family members age 14-19 who are players in the WYHA may fulfill hours as: score keeper, time keeper, and penalty box for any Mite through Pee Wee and Girls U10 and U12, if the individual has sought training on the equipment.

Hardship Policy

On occasion, there are families that are experiencing a hardship and are unable to fulfill their volunteer hour commitment. **Volunteer hours are NOT to be shared or transferred from one family to another without BlueLine approval.** To get approval, please send a note explaining the circumstance to:

2009 – 2010 Tournament Assignments by Team

- Families may sign up for any volunteer position on the website
- Guidelines below attempt to spread the number of volunteer hours evenly across all WYHA tournaments
- Families can choose to sign up for other tournaments if assigned dates do not fit their schedule. However, two weeks prior to an assigned tournament, your team's families will be asked to volunteer for hours not yet filled by web sign-up.

Jan 22–24, 2010	Jr. Gold B/Boys U16	All Jr Gold and PeeWee teams
Feb 5-7, 2010	Goldstar	All C League teams
Mar 2-12, 2010	Districts	All Squirt, Girls U10 and below teams
Mar 4 – Mar 7, 2010	Regionals	All WYHA Teams
Mar 12-14, 2010	Mite Madness	All Mite teams – youth and girls
Mar 18- Mar 21, 2010	State	All WYHA Teams

Additional hours will need to be done for Regional and State, WYHA hosted tournaments.

Mites are assigned to concession stand duty at Central and will receive their schedule once teams are formed.

One hour training for Timekeeping will be available throughout the season and will count towards volunteer hours.
