MN Hockey 'Participation Rule'

The new MN Hockey Participation Rule will now allow players the option of playing where they live or where they go to school. Some special provisions of the rule as it pertains to WYHA:

Players must be residents within the WYHA association boundaries (same as School District #284) or attending school (public or private school open enrollees) within District #284 geographic boundaries for one year before they are eligible for "A" teams.

Note: Private school and open-enrollees will be **required to obtain a waiver from their 'home' association and provide school attendance verification each school year** to the WYHA registrars before their registrations will be accepted.

If the submitted address OR submitted school verification is found to be fraudulent all fees paid to WYHA will be forfeited and the players' registration denied.
